
The Following Agenda were discussed and resolved:

Agenda 13.1: Review and approval of the previous meeting minutes.

Resolution 13.1: The minutes of the meeting held on **21.05.2021** was ratified by the council after the review and also the Council reviewed the action taken reports with respect to the suggestions given by the Members of the Council during meeting and approved.



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Agenda 13.2: Value added programs/Certificate Courses/ Bridge Courses

Resolution 13.2: The Committee members discussed about conduct of Value –Added Courses & Certificate Courses for the academic year 2022 – 2023. The members insisted on conducting VAC, CC and Bridge courses to suit the needs of the students and the society.

Agenda 13.3: Infrastructural facilities created and proposed

Resolution 13.3: The Governing council appreciated the infrastructural facilities of AEC. Principal presented the proposed plan of activities for the next academic year 2022-2023 and the council approved the activities mentioned in the proposal for the academic year 2022-2023. Mrs.S. Arunadevi asked about the hostel facilities. The present capacity is sufficient to accommodate the students, who seek admission in the hostels.

Agenda 13.4 Training and Placement activities

Resolution 13.4: Dr.S.Sharavanan suggested a specific Taskforce to be constituted for mentoring students in attitude perspective to help them understand the real work environment and adapt to it and also he suggested that Students can be encouraged to take up Internships from first year onwards for practical exposure.

Agenda13.5: Anna University Result Analysis

Resolution 13.5: The Performance of students and analysis of results in Nov/Dec 2021 Anna university were discussed and the council expressed their views and appreciated for the performance. Mrs.S. Arunadevi has suggested to improve the overall pass percentage and rank holders may be motivated to achieve university ranks.

Agenda 13.6: Income and Expenses for 2021-2022 and Budget for 2022-2023

Resolution 13.6: The Principal presented the details of Income and Expenses for 2021-2022 (recurring expenditure and expenditure for capital items and fixed assets) and also Budget for 2022-2023 (proposed income and expenditure of the institute includes students and faculty skill enhancement).

Agenda 13.7: Staff Recruitment and discussion on relieving staff members

Resolution 13.7: All HoD's were instructed to submit the requirement of faculty members as per university standards and to full fill at the earliest on priority basis.

Agenda 13.8: Faculty Performance Appraisal

Resolution 13.8: The Governing Council reviewed the faculty performance appraisal format and the procedure being followed. The Governing Council members appreciated the Principal for designing and implementing a standard format for Faculty Performance Appraisal.

Agenda 13.9: Students Activities beyond curriculum, Achievement recognitions.

Resolution 13.9: The Governing council members expressed happiness about the students activities beyond curriculum, their achievements and recognitions through various forums like ICT Academy, IBM, etc. Dr.V.Rajkumar appreciated about, contents beyond syllabus are identified as gap areas in the curriculum and contemporary issues relevant to the domain are taught in the class room.



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Agenda 13.10: Financial support from Management through Fee concession I Fee waiver, Cash awards from AEC and through Scholarship from TKVTSSMECT to Meritorious Students and Economically backward Students.

Resolution 13.10: The Governing Council appreciated the financial support by AEC and TKVTSSMECT to meritorious students and economically backward students through various schemes and advised to continue the novel scheme.

Agenda 13.11: Research and Development.

Resolution 13.11: The Committee members appreciated the steps taken by the college for the submission of project proposals to various funding agencies. It is also suggested to increase the number of proposals for funded projects. The members also suggested organizing, conducting and encouraging faculty members to actively participate in faculty contribution (R&D) and training process. Mr.N.V.Chandrasekar, insist that Faculty without Ph.D shall be encouraged to register for the same. He also suggested to constitute a forum for enhancing publications to encourage and guide faculty members in publishing more papers. The committee members discussed that incentives may be announce for appreciating the good work done and for encouraging quality research output through publications, patents and funded projects.

Agenda 13.12: NIRF and ARIIA ATAL Rankings

Resolution 13.12: Dr.V.Rajkumar suggested that the institute may set specific goals / targets in terms of NIRF ranking, converting some labs into Centre of Excellence focusing on identified areas etc. and plan and work towards achieving the same. The members appreciated for receiving the Atal Ranking 2021 Certification under Band: Promising.

Agenda13.13: NBA Accreditation, NAAC and Autonomous Work

Resolution 13.13: The principal conveyed that UGC's visit for autonomous status is expected to be on month of June 2022. The committee members reviewed the Autonomous accreditation work. The committee members instructed to Prepare in full swing and now the works are to be speed up for Autonomous inspection. The Governing Council considered the matter and entrusted the principal with the responsibility to prepare the documents by involving all faculty members for the upcoming autonomous inspection. Dr.A.S Ganesan appreciated that the various committees are in effective practice that makes up the running of the institution. The Governing council reviewed the admission status of the existing UG programmes and observed that starting new programmes / increase in intake in existing programmes is possible only after obtaining NBA accreditation.

Agenda 13.14: Admission and Quality of Students

Resolution 13.14: The Principal presented the statistics of admission and graduation outcomes of the current academic year in comparison with last five years. He also expressed the challenges in admission faced by the institute – due to multiple counselling for Medical / Agri related programmes and subsequent withdrawals / dropouts from the institute. Mr.J.S.Sathishkumar opined the declining in engineering admission is a general trend observed across India.



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Agenda 13.15: Any other matter

Resolution 13.15: Dr.A.S Ganesan appreciated the Institute for various achievements. He has also indicated that as per UGC requirements, the Governing Council should meet at least two times in an academic year and suggested that AEC should plan for GC meeting every 6 months. He also suggested that the names of the Governing Council members and its minutes be published in the website of the Institute.
